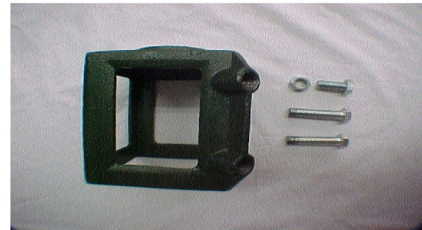


Do-All Traps Post Mount Assembly

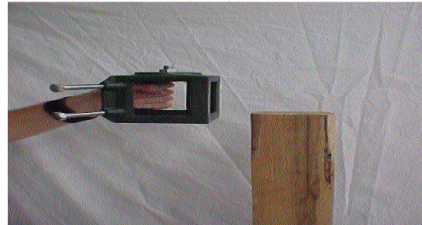
Item	Description	Qty
1	Post Mount Cup	1
2	3-Pivot Mount	1
3	Long Bolt	2
4	3/4" Nut	1
5	1 3/4" Bolt	1



1 Preparing Post Mount Cup

Insert 1 3/4" bolt through underneath side of the post mount cup where threaded end of the bolt is showing through the gear meshed teeth of post mount cup. Secure with 3/4" nut.

Insert the two long bolts into the threaded corner holes in post mount cup. Do not tighten until ready to anchor.



2 Post Mount Base Assembly

Slide post mount cup over a 4x4 post, pipe or tree stump(not included).
**The provided long bolts allow you to anchor the post mount cup on a 2x2



3 Securing your Post Mount Cup

With the post mount cup set on a fixed post, pipe or tree stump, screw the long bolts into anchored post tightly.



Post Mount Tips

The best height to mount a post mount trap is at waist level, whether you choose to stand or sit. Make sure the bottom of the trap head is about 20 inches from the ground.

For best results anchor your wooden post or steel pipe with redmix cement. It is best to set as much of the post or pipe in the ground as you have above ground. When using a tree stump the root system acts as a natural anchor.

Two post mounts shoulder width apart create the ultimate sporting clays station.
