
7. Reinstall door. You can now place your guns in the Gun Locker. Place unloaded handguns first, hanging them on the 1/2" pegs by slipping the trigger guard over the peg. Then load the long guns.



8. For single, double barrel or smaller guns you may need to place a spacer in the slot before placing the guns. This will help deter someone from trying to break the guns open in an effort to slip them out from the bottom.



9. With guns in place, close the door and place the 5/8" pin-lock through the top and bottom holes. I suggest placing the lock on the bottom so it is behind the door plate. It is more difficult for someone to try to knock off or tamper with it. Be sure to separate the keys, placing one in a safe place should you lose one. Also, record the key# and file it.
