Instructions for Installation:

1. Choose a place were you wish to install the Gun Locker (a closet or on any wall).



2. If you are storing a rifle with a scope, stand it against the wall: measure from the floor to the tallest part of the scope and write the measurement down. The lower down on the gun the better.



3. Using a stud finder, locate the studs in your wall. They should be on 16" centers. We have drilled the holes in the back plate of the wall of the Gun Locker on 16" centers to match the stud placements. Take the measurement from #1 and add 3/4" and mark this on the wall. This is where the top of the Gun Locker will line up.

4. Sit on a chair or stool in front of your chosen installation place for comfort. (You can remove the Gun Locker doors at this point if they get in the way). Hold the Gun Locker up to the wall and line it up with the studs you have located and mark the holes. You want to center the stud as near as possible.



5. Using a 3/8" drill bit, pre-drill each hole into the stud at the depth of approximately 4", the depth of the screws. This may prevent stud splitting. If you are installing in a closet end, there should be a double corner stud. Pre-drill at an angle. Always try to center the stud.



6. Now, line up your holes on the back of the Gun Locker with the pre-drilled holes and begin screwing screws in by hand as far as you can go. Then using a ratchet, tighten them as tight as possible without cracking or damaging the sheet rock or paneling. If the ends are secured to their studs, you may need only to screw two of the holes in the center.
